Dear Band Directors:

We hope all is going well for you as you prepare your bands for UIL. The Region 11 Middle School Band Concert/Sight-reading Evaluation is rapidly approaching. The date for this evaluation is March 26, 2024. The evaluation will be held at Steele High School in Cibolo, TX. We are located east of IH 35, approximately 15 miles north of San Antonio. Please allow extra time for travel since FM 1103 is under a great deal of construction between Steele HS and IH35.

Directions from IH35:

Take exit 178 and go east on FM 1103 for 4.1 miles.

Directions from FM78:

Turn onto FM1103 (traffic light) and go approximately 2.5 miles.

Cars may park in the front of the school. Please have all buses enter Steele High School by turning onto campus at the traffic light (Knights Way) and continue around the left side of the school to the back of the school on the Band Lot (the band practice lot/asphalt football field). The band practice lot is where buses will park and students should be dropped off. Please do not unload in the fire zone (red curbs) near the building as this will cause congestion, disrupt the flow and compromise student safety. Directors should proceed to check in at the UIL office located in the ticket office (foyer in front of the auditorium at the front of the school). Since fine arts classes are being displaced for this evaluation, we will not have storage areas and stands for warm up may be limited. All equipment must be stored on your buses or equipment trucks. Please ask your students to be as quiet as possible while going to and from their performances.

SCUC ISD has guidelines in place for all visiting groups to our campuses for UIL Concert and Sightreading Evaluation. Please read and follow these guidelines closely.

- UIL events are open to the public, but please note that parents without school-provided badges who wish
 to observe the evaluation will need to <u>leave plenty of extra time</u> to check in at the front office with their
 driver's license, scan in through the Raptor system, receive a badge, and then proceed to the auditorium.
 All spectators must check-in through the front office before they will be permitted to attend the
 performance.
- Directors and participating students will need to wear their school ID's while on SCUCISD property.
- If your school does not require ID's for students, directors will need to prepare student badges in advance. Please have badges visibly on your students prior to entering the school.

• Parent chaperones accompanying students will need school-provided badges, or will need to go through the RAPTOR system in the front office in order to enter our facilities.

Bands will enter through the courtyard and into the small band hall for Warm Up. After warm-up, bands will exit into the hallway and immediately turn left to enter the stage. After their performance, bands will exit stage right (opposite side of the entry door) and follow the hallway around to the right into the large band hall for sightreading. After sightreading, bands will exit the back doors that lead into the bus parking area.

Steele will provide bass drum, bells, marimba and timpani in the sight-reading room and bass drum, chimes, xylophone, marimba, vibraphone (no motor), gong and timpani on stage. Please bring any other needed percussion equipment. Steele will NOT provide triangle beaters, sticks, mallets, gong mallets, bass drum beaters, etc. A metronome (Harmony Director) will be provided for your use during warm-up.

Please bring 2 copies of your seating chart to evaluation check-in (ticket office in the front foyer). Since you are turning in 2 copies of your seating chart in the UIL Office, there is no need to email or fax your seating chart.
