Region 11 Band Directors,

We are looking forward to hosting the UIL Concert and Sight Reading evaluation on Thursday, March 38, 2024!

Things to consider:

- Directors and participating students will need to wear their school ID's anywhere on SCUCISD property.
 - If your school does not require ID's for students, directors will need to prepare student badges in advance.
 Please have badges on your students prior to them entering our schools.
- Parent chaperones accompanying students will need to wear school-provided badges in order to enter our facilities.
- UIL events are open to the public, but please note that non-chaperone parents who wish to observe the contest will
 need to <u>leave plenty of extra time</u> to check in at the main office with their driver's license, scan in through the Raptor
 system, receive a badge, and travel to the auditorium.
 - O Directors, please make your parents aware that the Clemens PAC is far enough from the main office that parent may wish to drive to a different parking lot.
 - o Parking is very limited on our campuses during the school day.

Bus Information and Contest Rooms/Locations (see maps for additional help with bus drop off and parking):

- Buses will enter from Elbel Road through the entrance on the far side of the stadium.
- Buses will drop directors and students at the rear entrance to the PAC (there is a road that circles around a small building) and then buses will need to park in the area behind the north end of the football stadium.
- Directors should check in at the contest office, located in the Fine Arts Building Ensemble Room (F114), upon arriving. A student guide will meet each director at the drop-off area and take them to the office.
- Cases should be left on buses, as space is extremely limited. If this is not possible due to buses shuttling students and not remaining on campus, please contact me directly.
- There are normal restrooms available in the PAC, but large-scale changing facilities are not available.
- Students will warm-up in the Small Rehearsal Hall (F102), located in the Fine Arts Building
- Students will sight read in the Band Hall (F101), located in the Fine Arts Building
- **Percussion equipment** (other than what is provided) will load in through the backstage door of the PAC. The door will open and *remain* open between band performances... please do not knock (3).
- ***Don't forget to get the contact information for your bus driver so you can call them when you are ready to load.
- ***Please note that school will be in session. It would be best that when schools are finished performing, they make plans to return to their campus. This will help reduce traffic congestion on campus.

Equipment we will provide:

- Podiums and director's music stands in Warm-Up, SR Room, and on stage.
- Harmony Director (new model) and McAdams metronome in Warm-Up.
- All percussion equipment required for Level 4 & Level 6 Sight Reading pieces will be present in SR Room
- Percussion provided on stage: Baby Grand Piano, 5 Adams Timpani, Adams 4.3 octave Rosewood Marimba, Adams Rosewood Xylophone, Yamaha Vibes, Fall Creek Glockenspiel, Concert Bass Drum, Chimes, Large Tam-Tam.

Things to remember:

- There are classes on the day of the contest, please remind students to be quiet in the hallways and building.
- Don't forget to bring smaller percussion accessory instruments, sticks, mallets, beaters, etc.
